



GHSPSA Mentorship Programme 2014-15 We Care, We Share

The third year of the Mentorship Programme was successfully launched on Nov. 15, 2014. We were happy to have recruited 79 F.5 and F.6 students in the Programme. This had doubled the number of students enrolled in last year. 26 past students volunteered as mentors, each of them was matched to three to four mentees. These mentors came from different professions and were eager to share what they have experienced in their career and personal life.

The kick-off ceremony was held at St. Joseph's Hall. The new Principal, Mrs. Laura Green and the new Vice-Principal, Miss Grace Pow, attended the ceremony and showed their support to the Programme. Many of our Mentors have joined the Programme repeatedly and they expressed the joy in sharing with the "little sisters" and found the Programme very meaningful as they could help the mentees to meet the challenges they might encounter in their studies and everyday life. Experienced mentors shared that they also learnt from the mentees and became more youthful in the encounter.

In the afternoon of June 27, 2015, some of our mentors and mentees had a tea gathering at the school to share about their mentorship experience and to evaluate the programme. We came up with ideas about effective communication channels between mentors and mentees that could enable the establishment of better relationship. In addition, the mentors were very generous in sharing with the mentees about their experience and tips in overcoming life hurdles.
