S6 Mock Interview Workshop 2018

On Saturday, 24 November, the Mock Interview 2018 took place. This is the 6th straight year the programme is offered by past student volunteers jointly organised by the Careers Team of the School and the PSA.

This year, we continued to receive the support of Ms Lannie Lee, Grace Siu, and Donna Titley. Grace is the career programme instructor of HKUST Career Center and Donna is a training partner of Grace.

They worked with our S6 students to get to know their true self and communication preferences through a psychometric tool Lumina Spark. Students were able to establish meaningful references for their future university and career choices.

Lannie, a former Jupas interview assessor, shared with the volunteer interviewers and S6 Hoppers on how to conduct and assess a Jupas interview and how to reduce anxiety and present oneself confidently in an interview respectively.

A new support has been added to our workshop this year. Former head of undergraduate admissions at HKUST, Ms Betty Law, a past student and a past teacher of GHS shared with us some key points to note in interviews and university choices.

Thanks to 12 volunteer interviewers, all the 43 participating students sat in a mock interview in groups of 4-5 people.
